Daniel 7

16 I came near unto one of them that stood by, and asked him the truth of all this. So he told me, and made me know the interpretation of the things.

17 These great beasts, which are four, are four kings, which shall arise out of the earth.

18 But the saints of the most High shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever.

19 Then I would know the truth of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth were of iron, and his nails of brass; which devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet;

20 And of the ten horns that were in his head, and of the other which came up, and before whom three fell; even of that horn that had eyes, and a mouth that spake very great things, whose look was more stout than his fellows.

21 I beheld, and the <u>same horn</u> made <u>war with the saints, and</u> prevailed against them;

22 Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom.

23 Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the <u>fourth kingdom</u> upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.

24 And the ten horns out of this kingdom are ten kings that shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings.

25 And he shall speak great words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.

26 But the judgment shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy it unto the end.

27 And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.

28 Hitherto is the end of the matter. As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.

Daniel has a dream and was told the interpretation of it.

The great beasts are four kingdoms (JST) not kings. America is the last one.

The Saints will take the "kingdom" (America).

Ten horns are 10 presidents (kings).

One of them (the last one, who was a previous king, see Rev 17:10) had a face more stout than his fellows.

THAT SAME HORN MADE WAR WITH THE SAINTS. – That is the CO time period. Notice "war" has a footnote to Rev. 17:8-17 where the dragon drives the woman (church) into the wilderness.

The Saints come out of the wilderness to take possession of America. (AOA has happened at the end of this 10th horn, also called the 8th king per John.) See also Daniel 12:1 when AOA happens after the last verse of Daniel 11 when the 8th king dies.

This 8th king (10th horn) does subdue 3 others. Pass the popcorn. Subdue means "by force, or military force".

This verse confirms the saints and the 8th king are at the same 3.5 years before AOA.

The Saints are victorious!
